

Unspeakable Forces was started conceptually in 2009 with Brian John Mitchell (Vlor, Remora, Small Life Form) talking to Darin DePaolo (IANTH) about doing a fun doom metal band either halfway between Jesu & Nadja or like Black Sabbath covering Pink Floyd. It took a few years before things came to fruition with Mitchell on guitars & loops & DePaolo on bass & keyboards. The results ended up somewhere between doom drone & industrial shoegaze.

On their debut EP, *Butterfly Corpse*, the duo combine a lot of the elements from their musical roots. Mitchell's guitar sounds come from the seemingly irreconcilable camps of thrash & shoegaze. DePaolo's keyboard settings & bass tones are influenced by Pink Floyd & death metal. This isn't thinking man's music & it doesn't want to be, this is riffing drone to nod your head to.
